SUSTAINABLE WOOD



We purchase our woods from suppliers practicing sustainable harvesting methods and most all our woods come from a 60 mile radius of our facilities in the U.S. Our on-site wood storage facility allows us to maintain the availability and quality, as well as offer a FSC wood assimilation program alleviating the time delay and premium pricing.

All of our wood waste is utilized as fuel in a bio-fuel furnace to heat our entire production facility throughout the winter. As a result, we require zero oil as fuel. 118,000 square feet equates to 130,000 gallons of oil for a traditional oil burner system.

MANUFACTURING



Our non-toxic manufacturing processes include upholstery methods that do not rely upon glue adhesives, encouraging perpetual product reuse, and solvent and formaldehyde free glue for all of our core materials and joinery.

We strive to minimize or eliminate our waste through material reuse. Excess fabrics are donated to design schools; leather remnants are saved and sent to a handbag manufacturer; and foam surplus is bundled and sent to a flooring company for underlayment padding.

TRANSPORTATION



Most all shipments are transported in our own trucks, blanket wrapped, eliminating the need for cardboard and other packing materials. We maintain complete accountability of all our materials as our products are designed and made at our facilities in Baltimore, MD and Red Lion, PA.

To cut down on cardboard waste, we ship our furniture packed in reusable blankets. Additionally, we have implemented a plant-wide cardboard recycling program saving over four tons of cardboard a month. Paper and aluminum recycling saves an additional 30 tons of waste per year.
